SEALINK REVIEWS FERRY FARES

Fuel price rises as a result of the Emissions Trading Scheme and increasing general operational costs have forced ferry company SeaLink to conduct a review of their fares.

“We have held most of our standard pricing and freight charges with no major increases since October 2007” said general manager Donna Gauci.

SeaLink had planned to increase fares on the 4th September with the introduction of their summer timetable however with GST also increasing from 1st October the company has deferred the changes until then.

“To assist our customers we will honour our current fares as long as they book and pay before 31st August.” said Mrs Gauci “We will of course continue to offer special deals for island residents which reflect fantastic savings and value for money.”

The company will be announcing their new fares mid-August, once finalised.
