

SEALINK ON THE MOVE – ONE LAST TIME

SeaLink's building was at last moved to its final resting place over the weekend of 1-3 April.

"It's been a long time coming" said general manager, Donna Gauci "Now that we are settled, it will be great to forget the distractions of the impending move and get back to the strategic running of our business."

SeaLink's move has been a result of the Wynyard Quarter (tank farm) redevelopment project by Sea + City and the current stage is planned for completion in July - in time for Rugby World Cup. A connection via the Te Wero bridge (adjacent to the Maritime Museum at the Viaduct) will link the downtown area to the Wynyard Quarter and is also expected to open in July.

Once work is complete Jellicoe Street will be reopened. In the meantime, driving access to SeaLink's new site will now be via Daldy and Brigham Streets.

Foot passengers are being asked to continue to exercise caution in boarding and disembarking vessels as the area is still a construction site and will continue to be so for some months yet.
