SEALINK'S FUTURE SECURED AT WYNYARD WHARF

SeaLink has secured a 15 year lease at Wynyard Wharf on Brigham Street. The building currently occupied by the company is in line for demolition as the Sea + City Wynyard Quarter project progresses along North Wharf.

SeaLink will move into a new building which will temporarily occupy a vacant site on Jellicoe Street diagonally opposite their current location. As soon as consent is granted for their new Brigham Street location, the new building will be relocated. It is expected that this will be within the next 12 months.

In the meantime the lease on SeaLink's parking area has been returned to Sea + City so that they can continue with their wharf re-piling project in preparation for the commencement of the Wynyard Quarter construction in time for the Rugby World Cup.

"This has been a lengthy negotiation" said general manager Donna Gauci "and we would like to thank all the parties who supported us during the process of obtaining our new lease arrangement."
