SEALINK AND FREIGHTLINK TIMETABLES VARY OVER WINTER

Ferry company SeaLink will have four of its five vessels out of the water for annual maintenance and safety surveys starting on Wednesday 27th April.

“In order to maintain a comprehensive timetable we have had to make some changes to departure times and there will also be vessel changes through this period” said general manager Donna Gauci, “however this has meant we are still able to operate up to 13 return sailings a day and thereby minimise customer inconvenience.”

Most FreightLink sailing times will operate half an hour or an hour later and the 3pm from Half Moon Bay and the 4:30pm from Kennedy Point will operate two hours later.

SeaLink’s services are less affected, with the Seacat timetable being maintained by the Seaway. The main weekday timetable variation is that the 5:30pm and 6:30pm sailings from Half Moon Bay will operate at 5pm and 6pm and the last sailing from Kennedy Point will be at 7:00pm instead of 7:30pm.

“We strongly suggest that our customers check schedules before travelling and pre-book to ensure they are not inconvenienced” said Mrs Gauci.
