SEALINK ANNOUNCES TEMPORARY WINTER TIMETABLES

At SeaLink we pride ourselves on our safety and reliability. To achieve this we invest in a preventative maintenance programme to minimise unexpected breakdowns. We are also required by Maritime New Zealand to remove our vessels from the water every two years for a comprehensive survey.

Due to this, our timetables between the months of June and September will be affected as we undertake maintenance and surveys of each of our three Waiheke Island vessels.

JUNE – SEPTEMBER SCHEDULES

1. From 5th June – 22nd July the Seacat and Seaway will cover services while the M.N. Subritzky is out of the water. This will have a minimal effect on weekday timetables, however weekend schedules will become 2-hourly from Half Moon Bay and the regular city service will operate.
2. From the end of July until mid-September the Seaway followed by the Seacat will be surveyed and therefore the timetable will be adjusted accordingly. The M.N. Subritzky will be utilised on additional runs as required.

Temporary timetables for the June/July period are on the website now and printed copies are available from SeaLink offices.
