Waiheke Island

In any one day on Waiheke Island you could: walk on a stunning beach, visit vineyards and art galleries, have a round of golf, enjoy a lunch of fresh local produce, try your hand at archery, shop in the village ... There is no dedicated motor home facility however a beautiful camp site is located in Whakanewha Regional Park just 20 minutes drive from SeaLink’s arrival port – Kennedy Point. The campsite has potable water, flush toilets a gas BBQ and is adjacent to several scenic walking tracks and a very safe swimming beach.

Great Barrier Island

Fondly known as “the Barrier”, this island is remote and rugged with stunning scenery, white sandy and often-deserted beaches, pristine native bush and more than 100 kilometres of conservation-maintained walking tracks. Native birdlife is abundant and there are many scenic spots to visit. If you want an adrenaline rush try surfing, diving, fishing, kayaking, mountain biking or tramping!

There is no dedicated motor home facility on Great Barrier Island however there are five DoC campsites to choose from, all situated in stunning locations and a dump station is located north of Claris.
